### Solvent-based sealers with Intergrain EnviroPro topcoats

EnviroPro Timberseal is the recommended sealer for use with Endure 1-Pack and 2-Pack, and Endure High Build water based polyurethanes.

However, from time to time you may find you need or want to use a solvent-based sealer. These sealers offer better tannin resistance and can help avoid grain raise on softer timbers.

If you need to use a solvent-based sealer under Endure 1-Pack or 2-Pack, Orica Woodcare advises the use of Toby GF Barrier Seal, Toby Rapidseal, Feast Watson Maxibuild Primer or Feast Watson Maxiprime.

- These sealers are the only solvent-based sealers Orica Woodcare approves for use with the Intergrain EnviroPro products.
- **Rapidseal and Maxiprime** are the only solvent-based sealers suitable for use under **Endure High Build**.

Timbers you may want to consider a solvent-based sealer for include Radiata Pine, Vic Ash, Blackbutt and some Oaks including European Oak.

Softer timbers will sand well but have a high tendency to grain raise.

Timbers such as Blackbutt have a tendency to tannin bleed which is sometimes seen as a greenish look on the timber and in severe cases may be seen as lines in the coating or picture framing.
